Maha Nasrallah

Biography

Maha Nasrallah is a senior architect and artist living between Beirut and Montreal. She taught architectural design studios at the American University of Beirut for 17 years and is a co-founder of the pottery workshop at Bkerzay in the Chouf area of Lebanon.

Working on small and large-scale projects, Maha has been running her architectural practice in Beirut since 2002. The main focus of Maha's work has been on ecologically friendly design. Some of her projects include:

- The ecological renovation of Casa Batroun in 2011, in collaboration with EcoConsulting. Casa Batroun was awarded the Gold Medal with the Green Apple Award 2103 for the Built Environment and Architectural Heritage, the BREEAM 2010 International Excellent rating in 2014, and the Lebanese Architect Award for Sustainable Architecture in 2017.
- EcoBkerzay, an ecological village built around a pottery workshop, in collaboration with architect and client Ramzi Salman. The project was built following all the criteria of the BREEAM International Bespoke 2016 certification scheme for Sustainable Built Environment, and in November 2018 it was accredited with the BREEAM Very Good score.

Between the years 2017 and 2023, Maha exhibited her artwork at several art museums and exhibitions in Jeddah, Beirut, and Washington DC.
